BSP also seeks teachers to work Saturdays at our school year program

- Students come to BSP a couple Saturdays a month throughout the school year.
- Aspiring teachers work with small classes of about 10 students.
- School Year Program offers a blend of enrichment courses and tutoring, tailoring each middle school student's schedule to their academic needs.
- Aspiring teachers are mentored by BSP staff, and receive training related to classroom management, lesson planning, and student-centered teaching.
